**\*Label your child's personal belongings**

- \*[The Complete Illustrated Children's Bible by Harvest Kids](#) - Harvest House Publishers
- \*Backpack (**Character backpacks are NOT allowed**)
- \*Water Bottle - we recommend **26 oz or smaller in size** for your child to hold. The water bottle will travel back and forth with your child's lunchbox, we encourage you to add ice.
- \*Lunch Box - [stainless steel or plastic lunch container](#) Note: Your child will be learning to open their own lunches and we want them to feel independent and not frustrated. **Please Do Not send your child's lunch in plastic ziplock bags, use reusable containers/bags to store food and save leftovers.**
- \*Snack Box or Bag: **Labeled Snack** - [stainless steel or plastic container](#). Note: Please label AM & PM snacks and place them in a separate container/bag inside their backpack. (PM snack - only if your child stays after 3:30pm).
- \*[Roll-up nap mat](#) (**No additional blankets or pillows**) Note: Nap mats will be sent home to wash on Thursday's.
- \*1 **small stuffed animal** for naptime - **must fit in their backpack**. Note: Stuffed animal is optional.
- \*1 Heavy Duty Green Pocket Folder
- \*1 Red Pocket Folder with **Prong Fasteners**
- \*1 Spiral Notebook
- 2 Packs of Crayola Markers
- 1 4-Pack of Playdoh
- 1 Pack of Expo Dry Erase Markers (Thick)
- \*1 Hat/Cap Note: We encourage each child to wear a hat during outdoor play in the warm weather. This cap will be stored in their backpack.
- \***An extra change of clothes stored in backpack** (shirt, underwear, pants, socks, **do not send shoes**). It must be VOG athletic wear and must be changed out every season.

**Important Information:**

- **Backpacks: must be maintained clean and neat with only what is essential** (green folder, lunchbox, snack container, water bottle, extra change of clothes, and depending on the weather — **a hat/sweater/jacket daily**).
- **A green rain suit will be assigned to your child at the beginning of the year. All rain suits are VOG property.**
- **Food: Keep in mind that we are a Peanut and Candy Free School.** *Save special treats for home/car rides.*  
**Send snacks in reusable containers or bags.**
  - Include appropriate cooling packs in your child's lunch. Unfortunately, the fridge is not available for learners' lunch items.
  - **Lunch Ideas & Snack Ideas such as tree nuts, dried fruit, fruit, veggies, bars, muffins etc.**
  - A microwave is available, but we ask that you limit the daily microwave use for the sake of time.
  - **A.M. Snack Time:** Send a hearty morning snack for your child to enjoy. Our snack time is 15 minutes each day. (If possible, NO yogurt/dairy liquids, this is helpful for managing time and avoiding cleaning up spills during our short AM snack).
  - **P.M. Snack Time:** If your child stays after 3:30 p.m., send a hearty snack for your child to enjoy during after-school-care.
- **Birthday Festivities:** Send a fruit platter, fruit cups, muffins, cookies, and/or toy goody bags to enjoy with the class after lunchtime. Parents are welcome to attend. Notify your child's teacher prior to the birthday celebration.
